We are hiring an experienced SLP to join our team and provide services to children in our classrooms and in our fee-for-service program. This SLP will serve children with a variety of needs that may include but not be limited to: hearing loss, language delays/disorders, speech sound disorders, developmental delays, stuttering, literacy, autism spectrum disorders and more. This is a permanent, part-time (0.6 FTE) position, beginning as soon as possible, but will likely become full-time quickly.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Master's Degree in Speech-Language Pathology
- Registered with the College of Speech and Hearing Health Professionals of BC.
- Criminal Record Check is required for employment.
- A minimum of 3 years' experience as a speech language pathologist in early intervention and/or school's is preferred.
- Experience working with children with hearing loss is an asset.
- Registry of Autism Service Providers (RASP) listing is an asset.
- Demonstrated knowledge of evidence-based practice.
- Organized, able to prioritize workload and take initiative.
- Ability to connect with children and their parents.
- Strong written and oral communication skills.
- Must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19. Proof of vaccination status will be required.

- Collaborating with classroom teams
- Parent education and coaching
- Developing IEP goals and assessments
- Intake of new referrals to the fee-for-service program
